$$2. \quad \frac{3}{4} \div \frac{17}{6} = \frac{3}{4} \times \frac{6}{17} = \frac{18}{68} = \frac{9}{34}$$

$$3. \quad \frac{2}{3} \div \frac{7}{3} = \frac{2}{3} \times \frac{3}{7} = \frac{6}{21} = \frac{2}{7}$$
