$$2. \quad \frac{1}{3} \div \frac{2}{3} = \frac{1}{3} \times \frac{3}{2} = \frac{3}{6} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$3. \quad \frac{3}{8} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{3}{8} \times \frac{2}{1} = \frac{6}{8} = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$4. \quad \frac{3}{5} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{3}{5} \times \frac{4}{3} = \frac{12}{15} = \frac{4}{5}$$
