$$2. \quad \frac{7}{3} \div \frac{9}{5} = \frac{7}{3} \times \frac{5}{9} = \frac{35}{27} = 1\frac{8}{27}$$

$$3. \quad \frac{4}{3} \div \frac{3}{2} = \frac{4}{3} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{8}{9}$$
