$$1. 3 \div \frac{7}{8} = \frac{3}{1} \div \frac{7}{8} = \frac{3}{1} \times \frac{8}{7} = \frac{24}{7} = 3\frac{3}{7}$$

$$2. 9 \div \frac{2}{3} = \frac{9}{1} \div \frac{2}{3} = \frac{9}{1} \times \frac{3}{2} = \frac{27}{2} = 13\frac{1}{2}$$

$$3. 7 \div \frac{6}{7} = \frac{7}{1} \div \frac{6}{7} = \frac{7}{1} \times \frac{7}{6} = \frac{49}{6} = 8\frac{1}{6}$$
