$$1. \quad 4 \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{4}{1} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{4}{1} \times \frac{4}{3} = \frac{16}{3} = 5\frac{1}{3}$$

$$2. \quad 2 \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{1} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{1} \times \frac{2}{1} = 4$$

$$3. \quad 7 \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{7}{1} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{7}{1} \times \frac{2}{1} = 14$$

$$4. \quad \frac{2}{3} \div 4 = \frac{2}{3} \div \frac{4}{1} = \frac{2}{3} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{12} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$5. \quad 3 \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{3}{1} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{3}{1} \times \frac{4}{3} = \frac{12}{3} = 4$$

$$6. \quad \frac{1}{2} \div 5 = \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{5}{1} = \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{10}$$

$$7. \quad 3 \div \frac{1}{7} = \frac{3}{1} \div \frac{1}{7} = \frac{3}{1} \times \frac{7}{1} = 21$$

$$8. \quad 4 \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{4}{1} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{4}{1} \times \frac{2}{1} = 8$$

$$9. \quad \frac{1}{3} \div 5 = \frac{1}{3} \div \frac{5}{1} = \frac{1}{3} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{15}$$

$$10. \quad \frac{8}{9} \div 5 = \frac{8}{9} \div \frac{5}{1} = \frac{8}{9} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{8}{45}$$
