$$2. \frac{1}{2} \div 5 = \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{5}{1} = \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{10}$$

$$3. \frac{3}{8} \times 2 = \frac{6}{8} = \frac{3}{4}$$

$$4. \frac{1}{7} \div 8 = \frac{1}{7} \div \frac{8}{1} = \frac{1}{7} \times \frac{1}{8} = \frac{1}{56}$$

$$5. \frac{1}{4} \div 4 = \frac{1}{4} \div \frac{4}{1} = \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{1}{16}$$

$$6. \frac{1}{7} \div 5 = \frac{1}{7} \div \frac{5}{1} = \frac{1}{7} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{35}$$

$$7. \frac{2}{3} \div 4 = \frac{2}{3} \div \frac{4}{1} = \frac{2}{3} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{12} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$8. \frac{2}{7} \times 6 = \frac{12}{7} = 1\frac{5}{7}$$

$$9. 7 \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{7}{4} = 1\frac{3}{4}$$

$$10. \frac{2}{9} \times 4 = \frac{8}{9}$$
