$$1. \quad 6 \div 1\frac{3}{4} = \frac{6}{1} \div \frac{7}{4} = \frac{6}{1} \times \frac{4}{7} = \frac{24}{7} = 3\frac{3}{7}$$

$$2. \quad 7 \div 2\frac{2}{3} = \frac{7}{1} \div \frac{8}{3} = \frac{7}{1} \times \frac{3}{8} = \frac{21}{8} = 2\frac{5}{8}$$

$$3. \quad 1\frac{1}{3} \times 7 = \frac{4}{3} \times \frac{7}{1} = \frac{28}{3} = 9\frac{1}{3}$$

$$4. \quad 6 \div 2\frac{1}{2} = \frac{6}{1} \div \frac{5}{2} = \frac{6}{1} \times \frac{2}{5} = \frac{12}{5} = 2\frac{2}{5}$$
